Sunday Morning Competition Guidelines

- Players must have a valid **Men's Club handicap** to be eligible for net ball sweep prizes. If a player does not have a valid Men's Club handicap he will be assigned his valid BCGA handicap for 3 competitive rounds until he establishes a valid Men's Club handicap. In the event a player does not have a valid BCGA handicap, he will be assigned a handicap of zero until he plays 3 rounds to establish a Men's Club handicap.
- Non Men's Club members are only eligible for the days take for any Pot-of-Gold or Progressive Net Skin.
- All putts must be holed. No gimmes!
- For Pots-of-Gold to be in play there must be a minimum of 15 players competing.
- Summer POG will be carried over into Winter play and vice versa
- In the event a player has withdrawn or is DQ from stroke play he will still be eligible for non ball sweep prizes which includes: Long Drives, Pots-of-Gold, KP's, hole prizes and Net Skins.

Our hope is that all male members will participate and enjoy the camaraderie and sport that our Sunday mornings and Wednesday evenings afford.

Sunday Mornings Men's Club

Open to all male members and their paying guests. An 18 hole competition that features unique and fun competitions. Participants sign-in on our web site portal before noon Saturday. Pay your \$15 entry fee at the Proshop. Your fee buys you into a 3 flight competition with net skins, Pots-of-Gold, KP's, LDs and low gross and net.

Wednesday Beer and Burger

A 9 hole competition (front nine) with \$15 buy in and includes the same options for pots of gold, skins and sponsor holes as Sunday (more info page 4).

Midland Tools Cup (Point Accumulation Competition)

For the first 19 weeks of the Sunday, Men's Club player's NET scores will earn modified Stableford points. Note that some events the Midland points are doubled. The top 15 players at the end of the 19 weeks will share in a enormous purse! With the top point getter receiving the Midland Tools Cup Trophy.

5 Man Scramble

Teams are selected by a blind draw based on handicap. The victorious team has the privilege of representing Sunnydale at the Zone 6 Scramble (TBA) and a good chance to bring back \$700 for course improvements.

Net Progressive Skins

Your gross score less half your given shots on any hole, except POG, qualifies for a money payout if it is the lowest below par score on that hole.

Fifty-fifty

The principal fund raiser for the Men's Club. 100 squares are sold for \$2 each. Buy your squares before you play, it is an honour system so be careful with your change!

Pick Your Pro

On the weekend of a golf major you will have an opportunity to draw a Pro from a hat. Entry is \$5. Your net score from that Sunday's competition will be added to your Pro's Sunday score. Pot is split 50/30/20.

Hole In One Insurance

Be sure to pay your \$5 hole-in-one insurance fee. Check with the Captain or one of his assistants to see if you are paid up.

Wednesday Night Format

The pot of gold on Wednesday will be on #4, and the other eight holes will be progressive net skins.(half shot system) To participate in this, the entry is an additional \$10. The breakdown is \$8 to the progressive net skins and \$2 to the pot of gold.

A new contest for this year is the **par 3 challenge**, for holes 3,4, and 5. If any player makes three consecutive birdies (net or gross) they will win a dozen balls of their choice.

Another new element is the **\$1000 hole in one**. Each week there will be 3 players drawn (one from each flight) This will be one shot at #10. If you Ace it, you will receive \$100 from each of our 10 sponsors. Each week we will contribute \$1 from the ball sweep, to the second part of this contest. If any of the three players drawn, hit their shot on #10 within a flag stick, they win the progressive pot. In the unlikely event that more than one of the three players are within a flag stick, they will split the pot.

For anyone playing 18 holes, there will be a option for **skins on the back nine**. The cost is \$5, #10 will be a pot of gold, the other 8 holes will be **progressive net skins** (half shot system) You have to turn your card into the proshop, and not play alone. This does not qualify as a Men's club hole in one. The breakdown is \$1 to hole 10 and 50 cents per hole on the other 8 holes.

On the last Wednesday of each month, the Men's club is going to treat each **group to a plate of nachos**, after their round.@ the clubhouse

World Handicap System

To participate in Sunnydale Men's Club net events or any Zone 6 tournament, a player must have a current and correct handicap factor. This is achieved by entering ALL your 9-hole and 18-hole scores from ALL active courses played. Golf Canada provides many ways to record these scores from using the computer in our handicap room, entering on your home computer to downloading an app to your cell phone. Preferably enter your score

Maximum Hole Score for Handicap Purposes

The maximum score you can enter is a net double bogey. A net double bogey is par plus two, plus any strokes you receive for the hole.

Exceptional Scores

An exceptional score is defined as a score that is 7.0 to 9.9 shots better than your handicap index.

If you record an "exceptional score" your 20 previous score differentials will be lowered by one shot.

If your score is 10+ shots better than your handicap index your 20 previous score differentials will be lowered by 2 shots.

What Scores Should I Post with Golf Canada

- 18 hole rounds
- 14 or more holes played you must post an 18-hole score
- 9 hole rounds
- 7-12 holes played you must post a nine-hole score
- Scores on all courses with a valid Course and Slope Rating, whether at home course, away course or out of country
- Scores in all forms of competition: match play, stroke play, team competitions



When you don't play a hole (e.g. you stop playing after 13 or more holes) record par plus any handicap strokes to which you are entitled, on each of the remaining holes (based on your Course Handicap)

When Scores Should Not Be Posted

- Scores of fewer than 7 holes
- Scores made on a golf course in an area during its inactive season
- Scores made not under the principles of the Rules of Golf
- Scores from courses under 3,000 yards for 18 holes
- Scores made in competitions stipulating the use of less than 14 clubs
- Scores made on golf courses without valid Course and Slope Rating
- Scores made on courses that are not a member of an Authorized Golf Association
- Scores made while playing alone

Sunnydale Men's Club strictly adheres to Golf Canada Handicap System.

If you have any questions regarding handicaps please don't hesitate to contact our Handicap Chairman Rick Sheldon. If you need assistance in posting scores please let Rick know or any Men's Club Executive and they will be pleased to help you.

Handicap Verification

Members handicaps will be verified on a regular basis to ensure that all rounds are being entered in a accurate and timely fashion (immediately after the round). Competitors who do not abide by Golf Canada Handicap System may be disqualified from competing in Men's Club events.

I. Playing the Round and a hole

1.1 After teeing off two players on the left side of fairway will compete against the two on the right. Measure a player position from the edge of the fairway to determine left right order.

1.2 On par threes, from behind the ball, spot its' position to the middle of the tee box to determine left right order.

1.3 Variants of game include two in the middle vs. one on the left and right; longest drive and shortest drive vs. the other two; two longest drives vs. two shortest drives.

1.4 If agreed upon on the 1st hole, handicapping will be determined by the difference between the low handicap in the group and all others.

II. Determining Score

2.1 A score is defined as points (beans, eggs, etc.). Points are generally assigned a monetary value to be determined prior to the round.

2.2 A maximum of the two points can be awarded per hole, excluding points for “junk”. Junk is defined as K.P’s, Shazams, 3 putts, sandies, etc.

2.3 In the event of a halved hole one additional point will be carried over to the next hole. The team that wins the next hole will receive an additional point.

2.4 K.P’s are worth one point. You can lose the K.P. if 3 putts are used to hole the K.P. K.P’s will be carried over.

2.5 Shazam, a putt outside the length of the stick, is worth one point.

2.6 Three putts *on the putting surface* to hole a ball on the green will result in one point be awarded to the other team. Four putts are worth 2 points to the other team.

2.7 A birdie is worth an additional point; an eagle is worth 4, an Albatross is worth 6. Hole-in-one is worth 6 points.

2.8 A pitch in (generally described as any shot holed, excluding your tee shot that is outside the fringe of the green) is worth one point.

2.9 When playing your ball from the fringe area you can “Call the Shot” If you hole the ball from that position your team earns a point. But if it takes you 3 to get down the other team is awarded a point.

III. Additional Points (adopted and agreed by players on first hole)

3.1 Sandies is any up and down from a greenside bunker. (Optional) Pars made from fairway bunkers and multiple sandies per hole.

3.2 Making a par while striking any part of tree is considered a Barkie. One strike per shot. Multiple barkies may be permitted.

3.3 Stealing the K.P requires the other team to make a birdie, and the KP designate failing to make birdie.

3.4 Making par from the fescue area is worth a point.

3.5 Making a par while incurring a penalty stroke earns a point

3.6 Calling your opponent’s putt in before it falls will result in a one point penalty.
